Together with Jean-Paul Bovey and Pierre-Yves Vaucher, we explored the beautiful Montenegro, spending also some days in Croatia and Slovenia on the way back. But exhausted by 1 month of non-stop rains, Montenegro was under flood and we saw some very apocalyptic landscapes everywhere ! However, we managed to find a lot of reptiles, with a total of 35 Vipera ammodytes. As usual, we didn't waste our time to look for the most common global species. Unfortunately, still no luck one more time with the lack of Z. situla, P. najadum and T. fallax in spite of dedicated researches. I also missed both endemic Dinarolacerta, friends having some other interests than lizards... But for sure, this will be done in a futur lonesome trip !
